Paint brushes

One of the cores of painting. So it must be properly done – and we know how.

Atlas is one of the few companies in the world to use the Monoblock System. What is it, and how does it change the game?

This is a manufacturing method, that fixes the bristles directly to the handle with epoxy glue. This makes the paint brush one strong unit, durable and resistant to solvents. Also, bristle loss is highly reduced.

A solid polypropylene handle provides the paint brush a no rotting, no molding, long lasting and solvent resistant body.






Paint rollers

They get the job done quick and are suitable to almost any kind of surface, but the quality of the paint job is directly related to the quality of the paint roller. Our paint rollers have what it takes.

Our paint rollers are produced under the Thermo Bound System, which is based on the heating and cooling of the roller core, in order to fix the fibre onto it.

By having no chemical adhesives in the process, our rollers, as well as our paint brushes, can be used with any kind of paint – including solvent based ones.





Tools and accessories

Football teams are not, or at least should not, be composed of only one or two players. When it comes to painting, we are proud to have a full skilled team on the pitch.

In order to get the job done properly, the painter needs a paint tray, extension pole, masking tape, gloves, etc. Of course, not before the surface has been properly prepared and cleaned. If there are cracks, we have the fillers. If there's an old coat, it's time for scraper knives or wire brushes – the point is, if a tool is needed, we have it.

And, then again, our products work together. But what exactly does it mean? For example, all extension poles will have the same thread, which means they will work with all our roller frames. And all our roller sleeves (36mm) will work with all our roller frames of 36mm.





Faux finish

There are no rules in this game, except that the finish has to be good. With a wide variety of tools, creative and stylish finishes are guaranteed.

Also, the paint sets are composed by the same "regular" professional tools bought separately. That means a roller frame from a paint set can later be used with another roller sleeve.






Skirtings boards
